**Note 1:** A child can be registered with either parent's band. However, if the parents cannot agree on the band, they can choose to have Headquarters register the child on a General List, until they can agree on the band.

**Note 2:** If one parent has applied (or is entitled), to be registered, but is *not yet* registered, then the child can *only* be registered with the currently-registered parent's band. If the second parent gets registered, the child can only transfer bands if the Council of the band consents. However, if the parents decide to *wait* until both parents are registered, then they can *choose* either band for the child's registration.

**Note 3:** This application can be processed locally by the INAC Regional or Band Office if the child has either:  
(i) two parents registered; or (ii) one parent registered under category 6(1).

**Note 4:** This application must be sent to the Registrar in Ottawa if: (i) the child is to be registered on a General List; (ii) the child was adopted; (iii) the child was born prior to April 17, 1985; (iv) the one parent is registered under category 6(2) and one is not registered; or (v) neither parent is registered. For situations (iii), (iv) and (v), Part 5 of this form with the Grandparents Information must also be completed and submitted.

**Note 5:** The parental consent statements are to be signed by both named parents, unless custody of the child has been awarded by the court to only one person, or the birth record identifies only one parent. If both parents do not sign, registration of the child cannot proceed, unless a substantiated reason is demonstrated why the missing signature cannot be obtained (eg; one parent is deceased)

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## Complex Consent Situations

	Situation	Response
2 Parents Listed on LFBC	Parent requesting the registration states that the other parent cannot be located.	IRA must be satisfied that the parent not signing the consent statement cannot be located before they can register the child.
	Other parent is deceased.	Consenting parent must provide a copy of the death certificate.
	Only one parent signs consents even though the other parent can be located.	IRA must contact the second parent whose whereabouts are known and who has not signed consent by registered letter. The Other Parent has a reasonable amount of time (e.g. 30 days) to indicate whether the child should be registered. If no reply is received within the specified time frame then the child will be registered in accordance with the wishes of the parent who <i>has</i> signed the consent statement.
	Parents disagree on whether the child should be registered	IRA should not register the child until the parents can agree.
	Parents disagree about the band/registry group with which the child should be affiliated.	The IRA should inform the parents by registered mail that registering the child will be delayed until they can agree which Band the child is to be affiliated. If, after 30 days, the parents have not agreed, the child may be registered on a General List. No BCR will later be required to move the child's name from the General List to one of the parent's Bands, but if the Band chosen is section 10 the child will have to apply for membership.
1 Parent Listed on LFBC	2 individuals have signed consent (someone other than who is listed on the birth certificate is claiming to be a parent).	Both parents will have to complete a Statutory Declaration signed by a Commissioner for Oaths that confirms the paternity of the child. The original stat decs must be submitted with the application.
There are Court Documents regarding Custody of the child.	Court has given permanent <b>sole custody to one parent.</b>	Only that parent's consent is required.
	Court has given permanent <b>joint custody to both parents.</b>	Both parents' consent is required.

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## Indian Registry

The Indian Registry is the official record identifying all Status Indians in Canada. Status Indians are those registered with the federal government as Indians according to the terms of the Indian Act. The Indian Register contains the names of all Status Indians, together with information such as dates of birth, death, marriage and divorce, as well as records of persons transferring from one band (or First Nation community) to another. Each month, the Indian Registry will post band registry of who registered or who transferred out and total population of band.

Identification requirements for Indian Registry:

### Application for Certificate of Indian Status

- Must provide one of which must have a photo and health card. If an individual does provide photo id, he/she can provide health card and IRA can help with guarantor form

### Child and Adult Application form

- Must provide long form Birth Certificate (both parents listed)

### Marriage

- Must provide Marriage Certificate

### Divorce

- Must provide Certificate of Divorce

### Band transfer

- Must provide statement of consent who wishes to transfer must sign and date a statement of consent
- Admitting and releasing Band Council Resolution (BCR), duly signed by a quorum of the council
